
WINNERS Student stories from Ramtha's Advanced Retreat emailed to RSE March 1 and 2, 2013



1. Alicia Benavides, Cancun, Mexico. Today I did my disciplines. I apply my learning. I went to the casino, choose a machine with a symbol that I see in the candle and with a light heart I won 200 dollars, double from yesterday.



2. Hollie Giacone, Kerman, Calif. I saw some numbers in C&E then the orbs gave me the number 15 through the iOvilus app. I went to the a little convenience store in the small farming community where I live. The store was very chaotic and busy. There were a lot of different forms. I have never liked gambling so I was not familiar with the different games. I looked at them all and decided I may as well go for it. Let's do the Super Lotto 30 million & the Mega Millions 19 million. The store was very busy so I stand in line to pay for my tickets. When I hand them to the clerk the line of people is growing behind me and he can't get the mega millions ticket to go through the scanner. He hands me back the form & says I have to redo the form. Feeling anxious I tell him no, I'll just take the Super Lotto ticket. I purchased it and quickly ran back home to make it in time for the stream. After class, I checked my Super Lotto ticket. I hit 3 out of 4 numbers and won \$8. I thought just for fun let's check the Mega millions numbers. (I used the same numbers for that ticket but that is the ticket that wouldn't scan). My numbers hit 4 out of 6 numbers. I would have made \$93 if I had taken the time to self correct and redo the form. Now I realize this is like the tank. You have to stay focused even in line to pay for a ticket. I learned that you must follow through all the way. 15 -- the number the orbs told me -- HIT IN BOTH. I went to bed and I asked my God to wake me at 3:00 am. The orbs on the iOvilus app said PORCH. That is were I usually do my grid work. I did the grid, created my day, did a walk "I have always been a winner" then candle focus. I got into a very deep focus. I saw the words Take the Journey" and I was also given some numbers. I wrote them down then

went back to bed. When I awoke to do the morning walk I just knew that I had to FIND a casino. It was an hour drive from where I live. For me to do C&E, then get to the Casino and back for class at 7 pm, I will only have an hour to stay at the Casino. I decide this is going to be very clean. Go in, Bet, Win, Go to class. Then I said, "OK God, it's you & me. Whatever it takes. Let's Do it. I want to experience you." I took the journey to the Casino. I have never been there before. I get inside & it's full of machines and tables and people and I am looking for the power ball table (they don't have roulette) so this is the closest thing.. I'm ready I have my numbers & the power ball table is CLOSED. Panic starts to creep in. I start walking around like JZ said. I say to my God, "Okay, I'm here. I took the journey? What do you want me to do?" I get the impression I'm supposed to just walk around, allow the info to come, & then check the power ball station. I find a machine. I have absolutely no idea what to push or bet or what any of these symbols mean. I came here to focus on numbers. I don't know what it looks like to win on any of these machines because I have never played them. I think about JZ and Big Ben & my journey, so I put in \$20 and play there for a few minutes. Still not understanding what I'm supposed to focus on, I lost \$7. I cashed out and walked through the machines and said my list, then I ran into the Big Spin Machine. I thought "I can do this one." It was a little simpler looking and had a lever to Pull. It had some bars and sevens and cherries. But I still didn't know what a win was supposed to look like. I decided I would just put the blue web on it we have been working on and focus on the word WIN. I pulled the lever, that thing started singing and flashing & I won \$213. I was ready to cash out and get the heck out if there! Then I have this thought "You promised God you'd stay for an hour and play the numbers you were given." So I quickly head over to the power ball table & it's OPEN. I ask them what I have to do. They tell me. I get my chips start playing. I won again. I quickly cashed out, Jumped in My car, and made it home by 7 pm. I won \$287 in less than 1 hour. But most of all, I took the journey my God asked me to take, and because I did, it manifested itself for me in entirely new way. Thank you Ram, JZ, and my friends the orbs who have helped me break through. I'm so in Awe & Excited about our New Magical Adventure!



3. Iliana Valdes. Coordinator for Cali, Colombia. Wednesday in the afternoon C&E, for the first time I clearly saw an 8. It was awesome. Then in the candle focus 18 came up. I woke up with a 26 Thursday. So I decided to go to the casino after work. When I got in, all the Roulette tables where full. I walked around the machines, sat down, and played 5 dollars. The machine had an eagle, which is the symbol I've been working since I created my year. I focused on the eagle and I doubled my money. I was so excited, that I let my emotion get in the way, and lost. I stood up, and saw a friend in the Roulette table. I asked if I could join her. I put 10 dollars in, and started to focus in my #8. The first roll, landed in 12. Then 8 hit. I played the 18, it hit too. I played a couple of different numbers, didn't get anything, I refocused and played the 26, and it hit. I cashed in 20 dollars. This is my first time for the Roulette. I was so excited! The important thing I learned, is that I can do anything! The issue I contemplated later, was that I admit fear to put a high bet on the number, even though I knew the number was going to hit. I didn't get to listen to JZ's talk today, but as I shared my experience with a fellow student, she said that JZ had touched that topic. Congratulations to all that with their minds have created winning!

4.Grant Rickert. Toowoomba, Australia. My remote view at the Realization Shop was a #7 and 7 days. My symbol in C&E was to do with gold. After doing the disciplines, it was time to go and do our thing to be a winner. I got a Scratchy

ticket called Set For Life, potential of \$250,000 per year for 4 years. It also has 5 games on it with smaller amounts to win, ticket price \$5. I scratched three gold bars which won me \$7 My first thought was, that was not much for 3 gold bars. BUT I then realized, I got my 7 that was in my RV. That to me was more meaningful than winning any other amount. Today in C&E I saw SET FOR LIFE scratchy appear, so after that, off to the scratchy shop I go. After the great talk from JZ, I got 4 tickets not just one. That cost \$20. 777 came up in a small game for \$10 plus with the other small games. I won total of \$22. Got another 4 tickets for \$20. Won \$17. My Grand total \$46 - \$45 investment = Profit of \$1. A win is a win, but of course I learnt heaps about myself in this journey and let go of heaps of stuff. The most important lesson was that I got my remote view from my God with the #7 and the gold, this was a great win for me far more important than the money as so many other beautiful masters have said.



7. Annie Rae, Tauranga, New Zealand. Until this week I was a stranger to slot machines and how they worked. Yesterday, I chose to fall victim to my past, became despondent, and I lost my investments. Last night and this morning I became fired up by listening to my fellow students, describing their battles with their cover-ups and JZ 's splendid talks. Thank you all for your wonderful stories they were so inspiring! Today I took \$30 and I was ready for the onslaught of my cover-ups (fear of losing, fear of not be able to perform, fear of not being good enough, fear of failure, self doubt, anxiety, and others). I was aware of the coverup pushing for a front seat in my frontal lobe and I self corrected. I was losing and down to my last \$2. I purchased 6 Electric 8's cards. Each card was \$2 so that took care of those numbers. I also promised myself during the walk that I would take action on the Lucky 13 that I saw and worked with yesterday. The closest card to Lucky 13 was Lucky Loot so I got one of those. I played each card as if it was its own field self correcting as I scratched each number. I went through the Electric 8's with no win. Then I played the Lucky Loot card. I was almost done with scratching the numbers and still no win. Then an attitude that was in my way revealed itself very clearly so I self corrected with "I have never been disappointed, I have always been a winner". I have 3 numbers left to scratch. I used them all and bought a power ball lotto ticket. 37 hit but it didn't pay so I wasn't a winner. On the inside I felt fabulous that my God had given me one clear number and it hit. Then I noticed my impatience to do the discipline didn't wait for my God to show me clearly what to do next. The second day I'd seen the number 23 in C&E, I'd also seen a part of a roulette wheel so I thought I would play 23 at roulette. There was no roulette table at the gaming room, only a picture of one on the wall. There were about a dozen slot machines in a tiny corridor off the bar area. I looked around to see what I would do with my 23 and saw a picture of another roulette wheel, as part of a machines decoration, with 23 lit up in the centre of it. I knew it was my machine, I sat straight down and pushed the 25-maximum bet, \$2.50 a push, on the fourth push I hit 20 free spins and the free spins kept getting hits when it had finished I had won \$71. I decided to go to the roulette straight away since I knew we had more of a time constraint to get back. I knew my focus was not totally there but I thought, "my god gave me the number, it's already happened, so just do it." I doubled the amount I put on the bets but did not win. I played the machines a little after that but knew I was gambling and didn't win any money. However, my greatest winning is I am aware now how important it is to take the beautiful gift of knowing the numbers into a state of calm, centered trust and not get hung up in the chaos which totally takes me back to the personality. So, I went to the casino Friday and had planned to play these numbers at Roulette. After having played the slots for awhile I walked around the casino focusing on the numbers I had created. I placed 10 chips each on of the numbers 5,15 and 25. Number 15 hit! Looking away from the table and recalling my candle focus, I then decided to play 5, 10, 1, 0. Ten chips on each. 22. Anne Willingham, Yelm, WA. Friday morning I was much more nervous than excited about going to the casino and as I walked my usual words changed.
