Oldest artifacts found, 40,000+ years old

A STUNNING archaeological discovery at Brighton could change scientific understanding of human occupation. In a new development set to rock the scientific world, the artefacts found in the path of the proposed bypass could be twice as old as previously thought. The discovery of the remains, that preliminary estimates show could be at least 40,000 years old, would give the scientific world a unique glimpse of a previously unknown period of human occupation this far south on the planet.



Ramtha: Earth inhabited 35,000+ years ago

Lemuria was not a great continent. Its shores were today's Pacific Northwest. Beyond its beach line there were lakes and swamps. My great elders — the great elders — knew a war was coming and they warned everyone. There was a safe passage made for us to Baja California and Mexico, which were all swamplands.

Our pilgrimage to Onai was through Baja California and Mexico. At the time of our pilgrimage, Mexico was not a stable landmass; it was a swampland. That was 35,000 years ago."
